**SITUATIONS VACANT-HELP NEEDED NOW TO FILL SEVERAL ROLES**

Please note that we have a number of Committee positions and other roles needing to be filled between now and the AGM in October. If you think you could help us with any of these roles, or would like to know more, please contact a Committee member to discuss this.

**Most importantly, the Club cannot function without a Treasurer to replace David at the AGM -if this could be you, please contact us as soon as possible.**

**TREASURER-** This role needs someone with a basic knowledge of accounting practices. Our Assistant Treasurer, Susan Murphy, does all the day-to-day banking and payments, and is continuing in her role. The Treasurer is responsible for overseeing the Club’s finances, preparing seasonal summaries and annual reports, and most of the processing of registration fees after Reg day each season. The current Treasurer, David Fogarty, has the role well-documented, and will provide a comprehensive handover to his successor.

**GIRLS REGISTRAR /OTHER GIRLS ROLES-** Meredith Donaldson is acting Registrar following the resignation of Gail Steel, but we need to replace Meredith at the AGM in October. There may possibly be a shuffle within the Committee, but in any case we need to hear from parents of girls who are willing to consider a role on the Committee. We can provide detailed job descriptions and all the support and assistance needed-the Committee works very much as a team.

**GRADE SECRETARY-GIRLS-**Anna Snell is resigning from this role after many seasons, so we need to find another Grade Secretary by Sept.18<sup>th</sup>. This role is largely done behind the scenes, in your own time, and involves 1-2 hours of paperwork each week of the season. The EDJBA relies on Clubs providing grade secretaries to do this recording work: we have four Grade Secretaries at any one time. **Please consider this- we need a volunteer NOW.**

**SECRETARY/ASSISTANT SECRETARY-**Kevin Jeans has been in this role for several years, but has many other demands on his time. We are seeking someone to assist us with secretarial duties, including agendas and minutes for meetings, rosters, general organisational matters and correspondence.

**WEBSITE ADMINISTRATOR-**Janine Gilbert has been in this role for several years, but is looking to hand over to a successor. This is now a key role in our Club-if this is your field of expertise, please contact us. Janine will provide all information and help needed.
