Venue update

We have three new venues this season:

- Croydon Hills Primary School, Campaspe Drive, Croydon Hills Melways 36 G10

We are eagerly awaiting the completion of our home ground, the SPACE centre at Ivanhoe East Primary School. Last word was that the building is due for completion by the end of Term 1 2011.

The future use of the courts at Banksia Latrobe Secondary College is unknown, as the school is subject to a merger with other schools in the area, and is re-locating to Macleod.

We can save \$135 for the club

Over two rounds this season the club has incurred \$135 worth of fines (\$15 per scoresheet), this is alarming! Last season (16 rounds) our scoresheet fines cost the club \$500 – so we're not off to a good start this season. If we continue at the same rate, we'll burn \$1,000.

Scorers need to always record the:

1. Player first name in full
2. Player surname
3. Coach full name

Any of these errors, however small, will incur the \$15 fine.

This season's errors will be communicated to the parents who have made them (via the committee).

Pre-register for Winter Season

Pre-registration also helps the selectors to prepare for each season. Pre Registration can be done in January through to Registration Day on Sat 26th Feb. Late registrations incur a \$10 late fee.

Scoring Made Simple

Before the game starts:

Write in the names of each player, First name, surname and singlet number

No nicknames, no initials, no abbreviations. Names must be written in full.

You must also write in the name of the coach

During the game, record field goals, free (penalty) shots and fouls as shown below

After marking this part, mark the running total off and write the players number as a check in case of a query. Cross through 1, 2 or 3 squares as applicable. In this example
 Player 6 scored a 2 point field goal
 Player 11 scored a 3 point field goal
 Player 10 had 2 free shots, scored 1 point

When a player fouls, the referee will call and signal to the scorers on the bench the number of the offending player. Mark a diagonal line in the fouls section next to the player's name, and then place the player's number in the team fouls column.
 Use a letter to record technical, Unsportsmanlike or Bench fouls when those are called. Bench fouls are recorded against the coach.

When a player scores a field goal, the referee will signal whether it is 2 or 3 points. This is recorded as a 2 or 3 beside the player's name
 When it is 3 points, the referee raises both arms with 3 fingers extended.
 Points from penalty shots are recorded with the following symbols

○ = 1 free shot awarded	□ = if 2 free shots awarded	□ = if 3 free shots awarded
⊙ = 1 shot missed	⊙ = both shots missed	⊙ = all three missed
⊘ = 1 shot scored	⊘ = 1 scored 1 missed	⊘ = 1 scored 2 missed
	⊘ = both shots successful	⊘ = 2 scored 1 missed
		⊘ = all 3 shots scored

ie draw a box or circle and mark a diagonal line for each shot scored.

Note that the time that a Time-Out starts should be written in the space provided

Get the other scorer to help by saying aloud the singlet number of the player shooting or fouling so you can record it, and ensure scores on the scoreboard agree with the scoresheet
