Timing rules for
EDJBA Saturday Competition Games
Commencing 9th October 2010

The game consists of two 20 minute halves.

The clock does not stop in the first half.

In the second half the clock is only stopped in the last 2 minutes whenever the referee blows his whistle. The clock should stop as soon as possible after the whistle is blown. The clock is not restarted until the ball becomes "live" again on court. (ie, not when the referee passes the ball to the player, but when the ball touches a player on court after the throw-in or rebound).

The clock now stops for ALL whistles in the last 2 minutes of the game. In previous seasons it did not stop for violations, and it was for 3 minutes, not 2.

If the clock hits the 2 minute mark during a timeout, substitution or free throw, the clock stops on the 2 minute mark and is restarted as above. (ie when the ball is "live" again)

Note: these rules change during Finals matches.

Note: these rules change when the temperature is over 35 degrees. (See Heat Policy)

Scorers are officials of the game and must show impartiality. This means no barracking for your team from the scorebench.
